Nagata Shachu 永田社中 based in Toronto, has enthralled audiences with its mesmerizing and heart-pounding performances of the Japanese drum (taiko) since its formation in 1998. The group has toured widely throughout Canada, the U.S., and Italy, and has performed at major engagements in Lebanon and Mexico.

While rooted in the folk drumming traditions of Japan, the ensemble's principal aim is to rejuvenate this ancient art form by producing innovative and exciting music that seeks to create a new voice for the taiko. In addition to having recorded five CDs of original music and five DVDs, Nagata Shachu produces its own annual concerts focusing on the presentation of new works. For the last seven years, Nagata Shachu has produced a three-concert season, featuring collaborations with both local and international artists.


